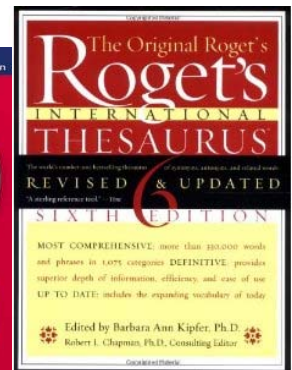
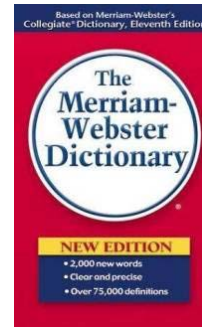


Supplies

The Materials Fee covers most, but not all, school expenses. Field trips and special projects, such as the Science Fair or Language Arts presentations, for example, are not covered. LCP students are required to provide their own college-ruled paper. In addition, certain textbooks, reference books and equipment may be required.

Reference Books

LCP students entering fifth grade and above are required to bring a dictionary and a thesaurus to school. LCP recommends the paperback editions of the *Merriam-Webster Dictionary* ('05 Edition) and *Roget's International Thesaurus* (6th Edition) (see photos at right). The ISBNs are **0-87779-636-X** and **0062736930** respectively. The dictionary and thesaurus are available at most online and brick-and-mortar booksellers including Barnes & Noble at the Americana*. A limited supply will be available for purchase at the LCP bookstore.

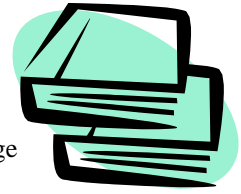
